

CSSM° Renewals Due by December 1

It is important for all current CSSMs renewing this year to note that renewals are due by December 1, 2014. Designees will need to complete four renewal credits of your choice by December 1. This can be choosing four of the 15 online sessions available at selfstorage.scholarlab.com, or a combination of two credits each from the SSA Managers Summit offered at our spring and fall conferences, or the SSA Social Media Boot Camp offered at our fall conference.

All renewal information will be emailed to the address provided when you last renewed or completed the certification. Once the four renewal courses have been completed, you are to submit your four certificates along with your renewal form that has been attached to the email. If you are interested in earning your Certified Self Storage Manager© designation, it's offered completely online so that you can do it at your own pace. Visit selfstorage.scholarlab.com, login and register for the 2014 CSSM program and complete each of the 15 sessions on your own schedule.



You will need to pass a final exam (with a 70 percent score or above) to earn your $CSSM^{\odot}$ designation.
